This is a unique opportunity to study with Drs. Bhattachareya, two renowned homeopaths, diagnosticians and teachers from Kolkata with more than 35 years of clinical experience who volunteer in support of the Project to facilitate this course in Ghana. Their approach to practice is grounded in Hahnemann's Organon and classical teaching, applied to clinical practice.

The Ghana Homeopathy Project has been supporting clinics at the village Integrated Health Centre for 5 years now run by Clinic Director

and Trainee Homeopath 'Emperor'. We are also holding regular outreach clinics to surrounding local villages where often 30+ patients are seen in a day.

This course offers you vast clinical experience in a primary care setting benefiting experienced homeopaths as well as less experienced colleagues who

will be able to observe and join the case discussions. There will also be scheduled classes in homeopathic philosophy in practice and materia medica as well as time for case reviews.

The Mafi-Seva community clinic is active day and night and many patients arrive often having walked long distances to seek help and medical treatment. The clinic also serves as a birthing centre with a local midwife present.

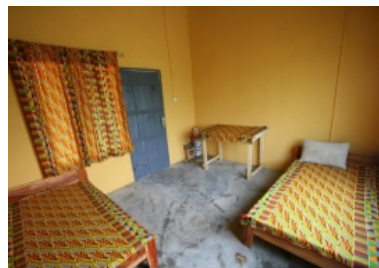


You will have ample opportunity to witness homeopathy in action and see the materia medica coming to life with many presentations including tropical diseases under the guidance of the renowned Indian homeopaths who are experienced prescribers for a wide range of pathologies.

The course is based in the rural African village of Mafi-Seva in the lower Volta region, approx 3 hours drive from Accra. You will be collected at the airport and the group will travel there by minibus. Accommodation in the village is simple in our newly built volunteers block with basic facilities, 2 participants to a room. All meals are provided and cooked in the village kitchen. We can cater for vegetarians.



We plan to take an overnight trip to see some of the surrounding area and have time to relax and socialise away from the busy clinic schedule.



This course is organized by Angie Metzger, homeopath and management team member of the Ghana Homeopathy Project in the UK. Angie has been to West Africa many times and has been working with the Ghanaian team for the past 4 years. She is also a lecturer and has taught on the first course offered in Ghana to train homeopaths supported by the Project.

This course will be open for some of the time to our Ghanaian students who will join the group in the village to participate and gain experience in clinical skills. The Ghana Homeopathy Project will support and fund this trip for our Ghanaian colleagues. You will have the opportunity to exchange experiences and we will learn from each other in this unique meeting of different cultures united by the spirit of homeopathy.

Places are limited to 8 participants!

The fee for the duration of the course is £ 730. – all inclusive: course fee, overnight stay away, accommodation, full board and transport, but excluding flights.

The proceeds of this course will solely benefit Homeopathy in Africa/ The Ghana Homeopathy Project, a UK registered charity (1125981). Any profit will be used to support the Ghana Homeopathy Project's aims and objectives of advancing and supporting homeopathy as a viable health care provision in Ghana and in support of the Mafi-Seva Community Clinic.
