CaHM therapists have been trained since 1998 at UCLan, one of the largest universities in the UK. UCLan launched the world's first MSc Homeopathy by elearning in 2006 and MSc Herbal Medicine and MSc Integrated Healthcare commenced in 2011.

We are now recruiting for all of these part-time courses. Their aim is to bring together practitioners from diverse backgrounds and locations around the world, with a view to working together to critically examine and explore the nature, tradition and evidence base of CaHM therapies.

Each course consists of 6 modules plus a dissertation; usual course length is between 3-5 years. Delivery is via elearning with live interactive sessions so that study can be undertaken at home.
